

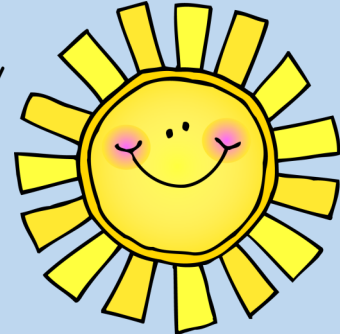


FLUSHING SCHOOL

All proceeds from the day will be donated to Great Ormond Street Hospital and the CLIC Ward at Treliske.

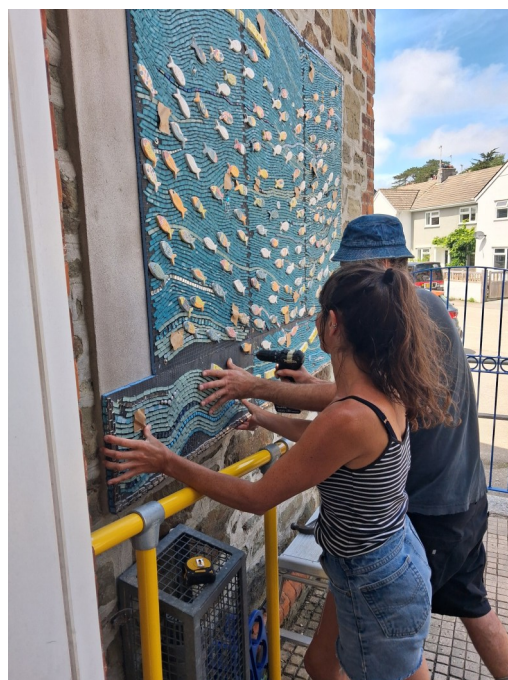
Sponsorship money can be paid either in cash via the school office or online through ParentPay.
