

#### **School Lunches**



To fall in line with Mabe School who cook our food, we will be charging KS2 pupils who are not in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, £2.40 per meal.

However, the 5 for 4 meal deal will continue to run this year, so if your child has a school meal every day in the week, as long as you have paid for four meals (and your account is not in debit), by 10am on Friday morning, they will get lunch on Friday free (so £9.60 for the week instead of £12). Please note that Pupils from Reception to Year 2 will continue to receive free meals on the Universal Infant Free School Meals programme. Thank you!
