The children were very excited about this and it was lovely to hear them speak so positively about the new academic year.

As part of our transition programme we have been enjoying some really good class sessions with our new Mental Health Support Worker, Alice Marler.

Alice has been trained by and works for the NHS and has been allocated to Flushing for a half day each week to support the children with their mental health. This term she has delivered an assembly introducing herself and is working with a class each week on feelings about transition, anxiety and anger. Next term she will continue to work with classes and run some group mental health sessions on all sorts of topics which affect our children's feelings.
