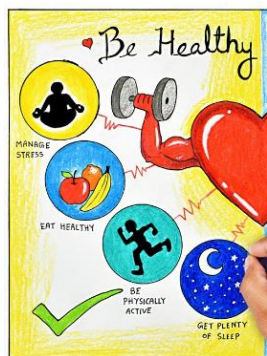


Homework Ideas
