

## SEALS Homework and Knowledge Organiser Autumn 2022 2<sup>nd</sup> half - The Flintstones



Over this half term you need to do **3 activities** (you can however do more than the 3 activities during the time period, and will be given Dojo points for doing so). Choose any three from the list below (My Maths and learning the times tables is compulsory). You can do your chosen activities in any order, but the first one must be returned by Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> November, the second by Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> November, and the third by Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> December. Amounts to be done for each item are guidelines. We are really looking for evidence of effort.

TIMES TABLES (this does not count as one of the 3 activities but still need to be learnt). Year 4 - to practise ALL times tables (up to 12x12) and associated division facts. Year 3 to practise and be secure in X2, X3, X4, X5, x6,X8 and X10 tables and associated division facts. THIS IS ABOUT SPEED OF RECALL. So, if they already know it, it is how fast they can recall it (expectation is that they can read, recall and write the answer within 6 seconds).

SPELLINGS - please practise regularly - tests every Friday.

MY MATHS - It is a good idea to do this as a final activity when the new learning has been covered in class. We have set 3 tasks, you need to do all of the 3 tasks to count as one homework.

**ART** - look at examples of cave paintings on the internet. Sketch a prehistoric scene or animal, find a stone, and paint a light background on it. Now paint your scene or animal on top.

**LITERACY 1** - Write a fact file about your favourite dinosaur and include name/period it lived in/where it lived/vital statistics (height, weight, length, speed, life span and any other interesting facts). Include a carefully drawn and labelled picture.

Literacy 2 - Write your own guide on "How to be a Flintstone" (Stone Age person). What clothes/weapons would you need, what food would you have eaten, where did you live, how did you make fire? Etc.

**HISTORY-** Create a timeline of the Stone Age through to the Iron Age. Put on the major milestones of the period e.g., building Stonehenge. Add pictures and photographs.

**Design Technology** - Research Stone/Iron Age jewellery and design and make some of your own. Try to make it realistic by using things that Stone Age people would have been able to find.
