



Dear Families,

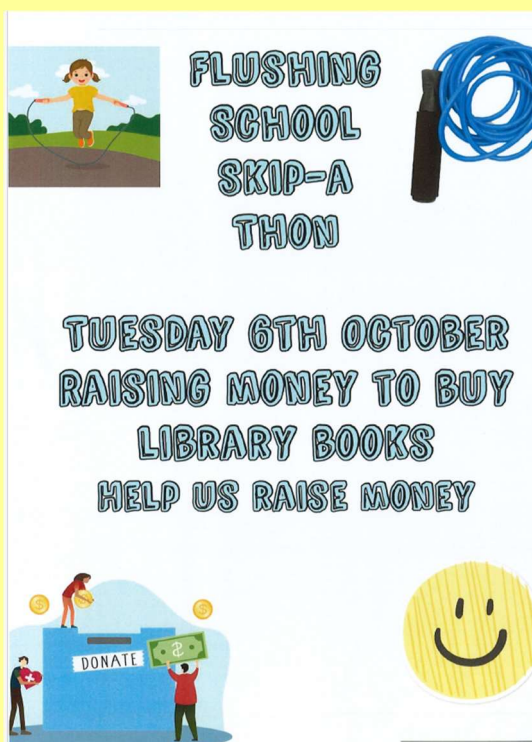
What a fun filled first 2 weeks we have had.

The children will be learning to skip during PE lessons and we will have a fun afternoon on the 6th, skipping to music!

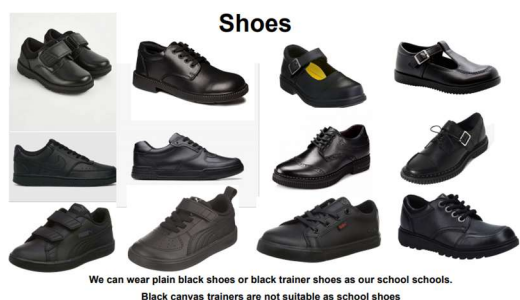


Uniform Reminder for September

Please find below our uniform expectations at Flushing. You can buy many of these items from Castle Sports Shop in Falmouth or on their website.

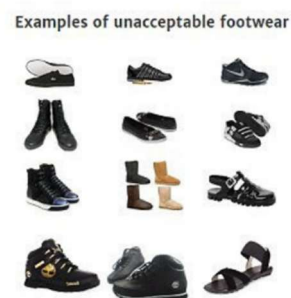
WINTER

- Black school trousers/shorts (no corduroy or jeans)
- Black school skirts or pinafores (of knee length, tube or stretch skirts are not allowed)
- Royal blue polo shirts with school badge
- Royal blue sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece with school badge
- Socks/tights (white, grey or black, multi coloured are not allowed)
- **SHOES: Well-fitting all black school shoes (that cover and protect the whole foot). No boots or training shoes.**

SUMMER

- Black trousers/shorts
- Blue gingham dresses, black trousers or skirts (as above)
- Royal blue polo shirts with school badge
- Royal blue sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece with school badge

P.E KIT:

- Children are asked to come to school wearing their PE Kit on PE days.
- PE hoodies are available from Castle Sports (optional)
- PE days are Tuesdays and Wednesdays for all classes
- PE shirts are available through Castle sports and black shorts.
- Training shoes must be worn for junior outdoor lessons. Plain jogging/tracksuit bottoms can be worn during the winter during cold spells.
