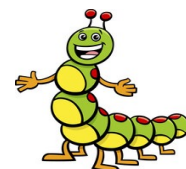

Walking Bus Passengers

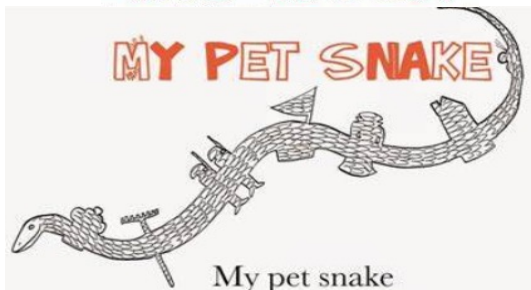
