Please find below our uniform expectations at Flushing. You can buy many of these items from Castle Sports Shop in Falmouth or on their website.

WINTER

Black school trousers/shorts (no corduroy or jeans)

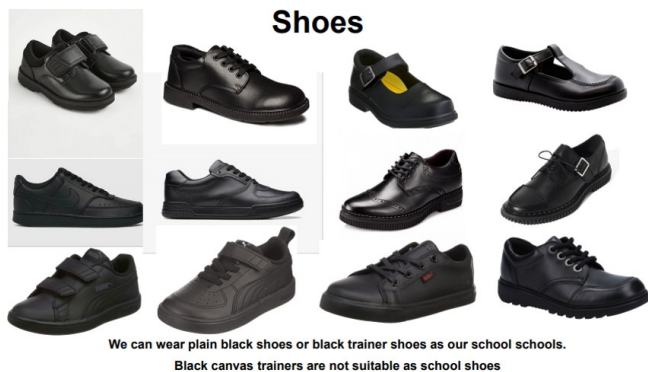
Black school skirts or pinafores (of knee length, tube or stretch skirts are not allowed)

Royal blue polo shirts with school badge

Royal blue sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece with school badge

Socks/tights (white, grey or black, multi coloured are not allowed)

SHOES: Well-fitting all black school shoes (that cover and protect the whole foot). No boots or training shoes.
