## UNIFORM

I know that lots of you will be refreshing uniform for the Summer Term. Can I just remind you of our uniform expectations:

#### WINTER

- Black school trousers/shorts (no corduroy or jeans)
- Black school skirts or pinafores (of knee length, tube or stretch skirts are not allowed)
- Royal blue polo shirts with school badge
- Royal blue sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece with school badge
- Socks/tights (white, grey or black, multi coloured are not allowed)
- SHOES: Well-fitting all black school shoes (that cover and protect the whole foot). No boots or training shoes.

#### **SUMMER**

- Black trousers/shorts
- Lilac/blue gingham dresses, black trousers or skirts (as above)
- Royal blue polo shirts with school badge
- Royal blue sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece with school badge
- SHOES: Well-fitting all black school shoes (that cover and protect the whole foot). No boots or training shoes.
- Socks/tights (white, grey or black, multi coloured are not allowed)

If children have pierced ears they should only wear plain studs and no other jewellery. Longer hair needs to be tied back for health and safety reasons.

- Next Thursday ALL children will need a packed lunch as we cannot use the Village Club due to voting.
- The following Thursday children are encouraged to wear something red, white or blue for VE Day. Parents are invited into the playground at 9.00 am to hear the children sing
