They have been lucky to have sun and a light breeze, so far...!



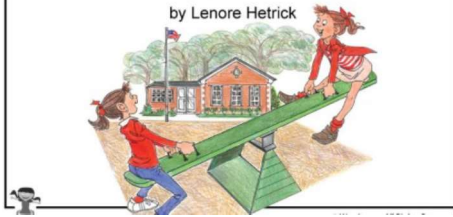
## Poem of the Week
