Children's Sailing Trust

As you know, the Children's Sailing Trust provides a Charitable Sailing Programme to schools across Cornwall, giving children the opportunity to develop confidence, independence and life skills through time on the water. This programme is entirely funded through charitable fundraising and each year we need to raise just over £300,000 to make it possible.

This year, I have taken on the challenge of running the London Marathon to try to raise £10,000 towards our 2026 Schools Sailing Programme (despite never having run further than 10k before!). Every pound raised will go directly towards ensuring children, including those with additional needs, can continue to access this programme and benefit from these opportunities.

Even small donations collectively help us sustain these opportunities.

Being able to offer these experiences means that every child has the chance to take part in something many would not otherwise have access to and seeing the difference it makes to your pupils is exactly why we work so hard each year to raise the necessary funds.




