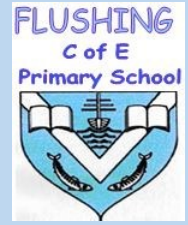




FLUSHING SCHOOL

The children are doing a great job and you may see the new STAR dojo award popping up when your child has been noticed showing STAR.

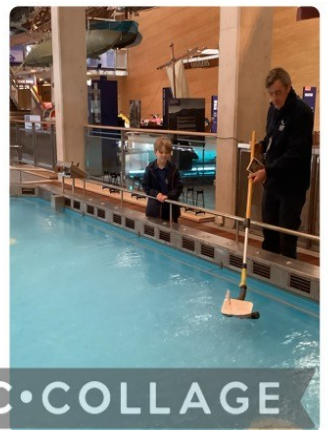
We can already see an impact on learning and we are excited to see how the project will help us further develop in the coming months here at Flushing.

The Village panto is nearly here! As I mentioned last week, they are incredibly supportive and generous to the school. Please consider supporting them and enjoy a fun evening out.

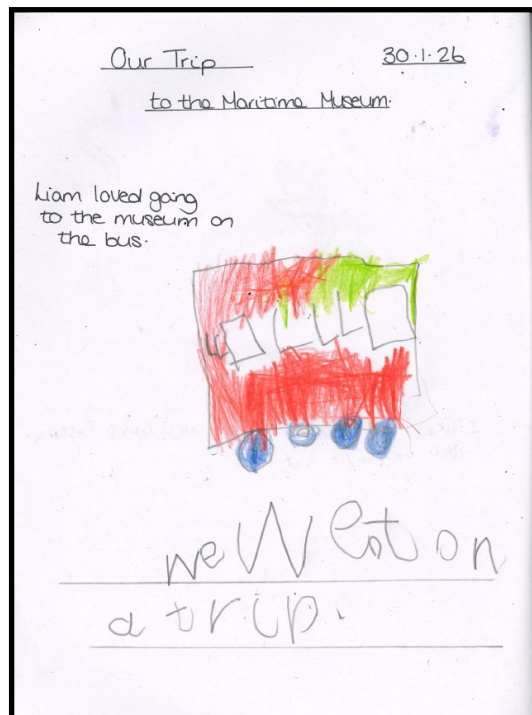
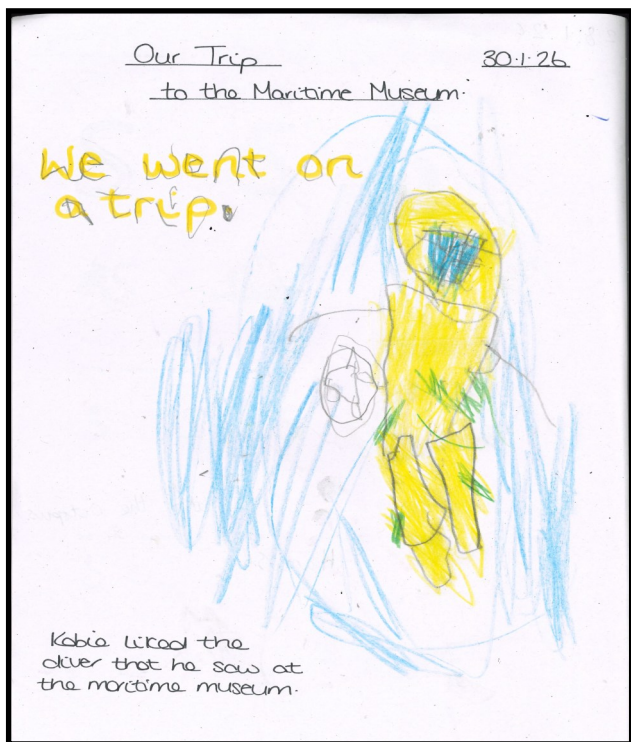
