


Sophie and Ellen on a Thursday are more than happy to help your children in their homework if it involves arts and craft. Please let them know prior to the day.

Do you have a child born between 1 September 2021 and 31 August 2022?

If so, you will need to apply for a place in a reception class in September 2026 for your child by the deadline of **15 January 2026**. The deadline for applications is 15 January 2026









Please note: you will need to apply even if your child attends a school's nursery or preschool class. If a school is oversubscribed the fact that a child attends a school's nursery or pre-school, or a local nursery or pre-school, does not automatically guarantee a place at that school.
