
### Change to Menu –4th and 5th March

#### Pupil Premium worth £1000+ per child

Pupil Premium funding is worth more than £1000 yearly for every pupil who is eligible for this. The pupil then gets funding for at least 6 years!! This could bring in so much more funding for the school if only we had more children signed up to this. Please can then ALL parents check to see if you are eligible below. If so please apply, it's very easy and only needs to be once. If you are unsure then please do apply anyway as this could really help the school.

If you think that your situation has changed and you might be eligible for Pupil Premium, please follow the link below to see if you are eligible. If you are entitled to any of the following, please apply for at School meals - Cornwall Council

- Income Support (IS)
- Job Seekers' Allowance (Income-Based) and equal based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA-IR) and equal based Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income of less than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working
   Tax Credit
- Guarantee Element of Pension Credit (GPC)
- Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (IAA) Support
- Universal Credit Your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get) as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods



I am really looking forward to seeing what the children come up with next week!





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


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
