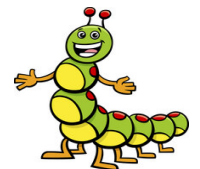

Working scientifically on a Skittle investigation.

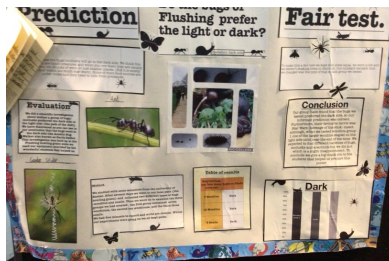
